Ticket Policy

We are very fortunate to have a music program that continues to grow in numbers here at Calabasas High School. Due to the limited seating in our theater, the following ticket policy ensures that all students are guaranteed tickets for their performance night.

♪ **TICKET PRE-SALE FOR ALL CONCERTS** – Tickets will go on sale at lunch time, approximately one week prior to each concert. During pre-sale, students will be able to purchase a limited number of tickets for the night of their primary performance. Each student should make sure to purchase his/her tickets on these priority days. Our parent volunteers will have a class roster and will keep track of ticket purchases.

♪ **GENERAL TICKET SALES AFTER PRE-SALE** – After the pre-sale period, ticket sales will be open for general purchase on a first-come, first-served basis with no limitations on the number of tickets that may be purchased. Any student who does not purchase his/her priority tickets at the pre-sale risks not being able to get any tickets for the concerts if the concerts sell out on the last remaining days. We will sell tickets during lunch through the days of the concerts, as long as there are tickets available.

♪ **SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY, TICKETS MAY BE SOLD AT THE DOOR ON THE NIGHT OF A CONCERT. THESE SALES ARE NOT GUARANTEED.**

♪ **SEATING IS ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS. THERE WILL BE NO RESERVING SEATS IN THE THEATER BEFORE THE SHOW.**

♪ **NON-PERFORMING MUSIC STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND THE CONCERTS.** Students will be asked to sign in at the door the night of the concert and will be given complimentary seats.

Letter to Parents of Music Students

As a member of the Calabasas High School Music Department, your student will benefit from his or her participation, gain valuable and educational experiences, and have memories to last a lifetime. Participation in the music program requires either the above contribution or contact with Mrs. Foss. No one will be denied participation after contacting Mrs. Foss.

In addition to this requested Participation Fee, Music Boosters coordinates various fundraisers to offset additional costs beginning with our annual gift wrap sale. This will be followed by our holiday See's candy sales and then our annual Dinner Dance and Silent Auction to be held in the spring. Plus, throughout the year you can support the CHS Music program by participating in the **E-Scrip program** and utilizing **two particular search engines on the internet**. These fundraising opportunities are explained in this handbook.

In conclusion, please know that your Participation Fee and Music Boosters' fundraising efforts will be (and have been) put to good use.
